All items of uniform except shoes and stockings are specific to Whangaroa College and made especially for us. Any similar items are not uniform and therefore not allowed.		
All clothing should be clean, tidy, in good repair, and be well fitting.		
When travelling and representing the school, correct uniform must be worn at all times. Senior dress Jacket can be purchased or hired from the school for all formal settings.		
Jandals are defined at Whangaroa College as any shoe without a heel strap.		
All items of clothing and personal equipment <b>MUST</b> be clearly and permanently named.		
Raincoats may be worn to and from school but not at school.		
All pupils are to wear the school uniform correctly		
Students are to be clean shaven and well groomed.		
No Student is permitted to wear a hooded jacket or top at Whangaroa College.
